

If you're stopped/ taken by officers or federal agents 🚔

- You have the right to remain silent. If you are a minor, you need the presence of a parent. Give the card to the agent or officer
- Stay calm. Do not run, argue, resist, or obstruct the police.
- Ask if you can leave. If yes, calmly walk away
- You do not have to consent to a search of yourself or your belongings
- Do not sign anything without speaking to your attorney
- You have a right for a local phone call. The police cannot listen if you call your attorney.
- You have the right to a lawyer

Please be informed that I am choosing to exercise my right to remain silent and the right to refuse to answer your questions, based on my 5th Amendment right under the United States Constitution. If I am detained by an ICE official or by a police officer, I request to contact an attorney immediately. I am also exercising my right to refuse to sign anything until I consult with my attorney. I would like to contact a lawyer at this number:

If you are at the door of my home, I do not give your permission to enter my home based on my 4th Amendment rights under the United States Constitution. I will only permit you to enter my home if you show me a warrant signed by a judge or magistrate. If you have such a warrant, please tell me and then slide it under the door or up against a window.

- Tienes el derecho de permanecer en silencio. Si eres menor de edad, necesitas la presencia de un padre o tutor. Entrega la tarjeta al agente u oficial.

- Pregunta si puedes irte. Si la respuesta es sí, aléjate tranquilamente.
- No tienes que dar tu consentimiento para que registren tu persona o tus pertenencias.
- No firmes nada que no entienda sin hablar con un abogado
- Tienes derecho a una llamada telefónica local. La policía no puede escuchar si llamas a tu abogado.
- Tienes derecho a un abogado
